**\* Definition vegan-vegetarian dedicated on the 12. Verbraucherschutzministerkonferenz (VSMK) on 22 April 2016 [translated by Hamburg Fructose GmbH International]**

(1) Food is vegan if it is not produced from products with animal origin and does not contain

- ingredients (including additives, excipients, flavors and enzymes) or
- processing aids or
- non-food additives used in the same way and for the same purpose as processing aids,

that are of animal origin, added or used in processed or unprocessed form at all stages of production and processing.

(2) Food is vegetarian if it fulfills the requirements of paragraph 1, but can differ by using

1. milk,
2. colostrum,
3. farm poultry eggs,
4. bee honey,
5. beeswax,
6. Propolis or
7. wool fat / lanolin from wool obtained from live sheep,

or their constituents or products derived therefrom during the production.

(3) A declaration as vegan or vegetarian is possible even if unintentional entries of products that do not comply with the requirements of paragraph 1 or 2 are possible, if it is technically unavoidable despite suitable precautionary measures and compliance with the good manufacturing practice.

(4) Paragraphs 1 to 3 apply if food information is used which, from the consumer's point of view, is synonymous with vegan or vegetarian.
